IMM Starting Next Month

Next month our base is starting our new sailing course, Introduction to Maritime Missions (IMM)! This is a 3 month course that teaches the fundamentals of sailing, crewing, and why maritime missions is essential for accessing remote and unreached communities. Elmer and I are not staffing this school, but it's all hands on deck and we will be busy when the school is here! It starts April 6th, then they will be going to Panama for the Month of May, and will return in June to finish the school! Prayers are appreciated for our 2 students and for all the finances to come in for their school!

Elmer's Immigration Paperwork Testimony & What's Next

As many of you already know, we raised almost \$2,500 in less than 24 hours for ALL of Elmer's Immigration Paperwork!! We were so blown away by the Lord and his goodness! His Adjustment of Status, Work Permit, and Travel Document have all been received by USCIS and now starts the waiting game... Please pray with us that all his paperwork goes through smoothly and we hear back soon!

If you want to know about his whole process until citizenship, then keep reading! Elmer will receive a Conditional Green Card (within the next few months!) that is only valid for 2 years. Before the end of the two years, we will need to apply to have his conditions removed, then he'll receive a permanent Green Card. After three years of having his Green Card, he can apply to become a U.S. Citizen! This process involves applying for it (and paying the fee), taking an English & Civics test, and having an interview.
